Busby Berkeley!

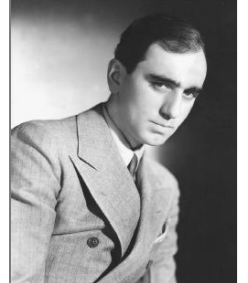
